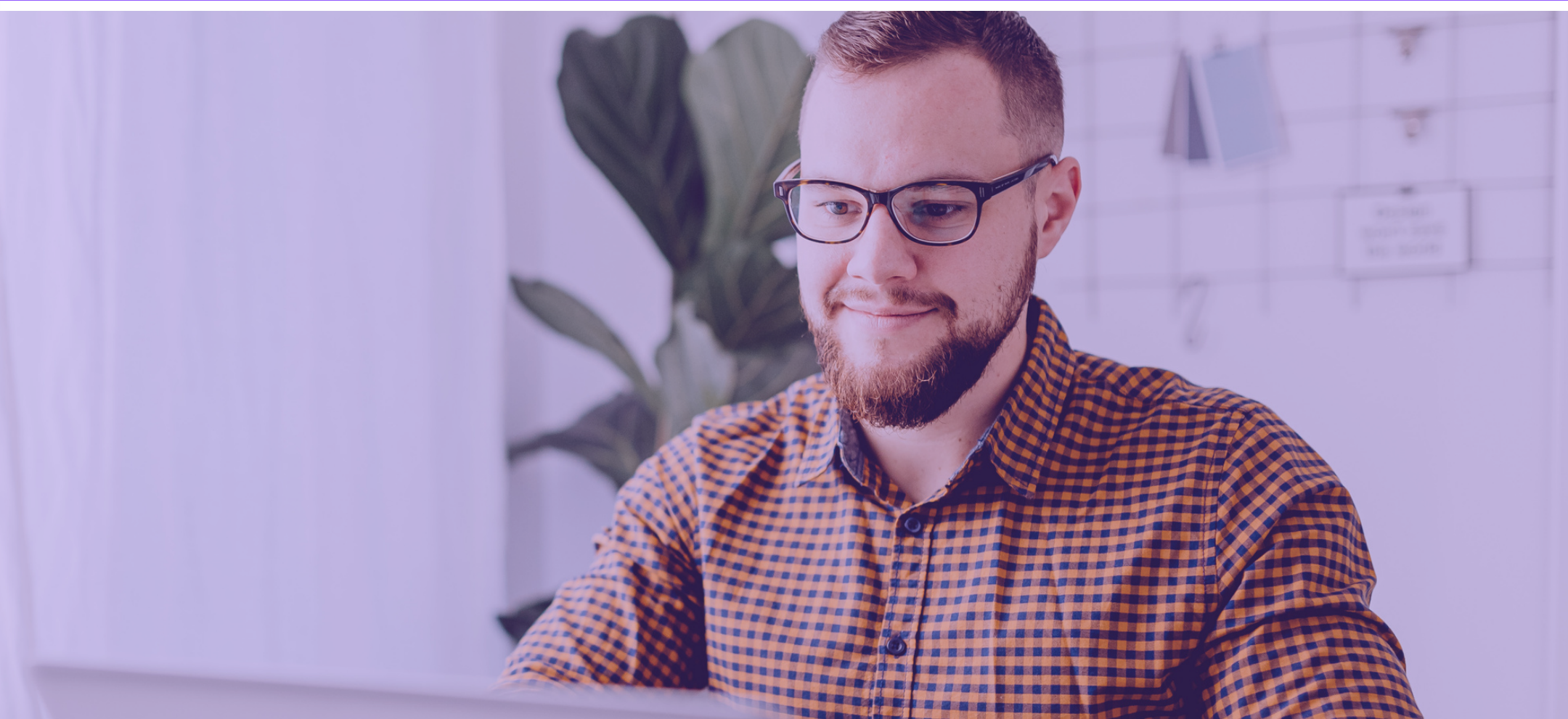

## → YOUR ROLE AS QUALITY ASSURANCE PHARMACIST

You will secure the pharmaceutical responsibility in back up and by the delegation of the Head Pharmacist.

You will be responsible for the operational implementation of the medical devices and medicines activities to ensure that all products distributed comply with the Group's and local regulations and guidelines.

You will ensure the local operational management of complaints relating to the quality of products and cases of Pharmacovigilance and Materiovigilance in accordance with internal procedures and to intervene in support of calls for tender.

# → YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supports the Head Pharmacist of France/QA Manager in managing the quality of pharmaceutical products and medical devices for the site, in accordance with national and international regulations, internal policies and procedures.
- Implements and updates the procedures and work instructions, in collaboration with the relevant departments and ensures effective communication and traceability.
- Participates actively in the improvement of the Quality Management System of the French subsidiary in accordance with the MDR 2017/745.
- Ensures the local operational management of quality product complaints in link with the Headquarters and the customers.
- Ensures initial and continuous quality training sessions for employees and the follow-up.
- Participates in internal and external audits (preparation, performing and follow-up).
- Support the French market (tenders, customers, partner companies...) in providing specific quality / regulatory documents in link with the Headquarters.
- Ensure the back-up of the Head Pharmacist and ensures the pharmaceutical responsibility of the "operating" site by delegation of the responsible pharmacist (RP) :
  - *Organization and control of all distribution activities, pharmacovigilance, medical information,*
  - *Batch release for the national market,*
  - *Batch recall decision and coordination in relation with the local management team, MAH and health authorities,*
  - *Response to requests/questions from health authorities,*
  - *Decision on product quality / complaint management,*
  - *Management of deviations / CAPA / Change controls : decision/validation/closure,*
  - *Review of Annual Product Quality Reviews (APQR) of pharmaceutical products*
  - *Follow-up of Pharmacovigilance data exchanges*





## → REQUIREMENTS

- Pharmacist
- Eligible for inclusion in Section B as an Interim Pharmacist in Charge
- Minimum of 5 years' experience in Quality with pharmaceutical responsibilities in Pharma and/or Medical Devices industry
- Fluent English and French
